Scholarship Fund Information

For over 100 years, the International School of Hydrocarbon Measurement (ISHM) has been dedicated to educating and training measurement and control professionals across all levels of the oil and gas industry. In the 1980s, ISHM established the ISHM Memorial Scholarship Fund to support students pursuing relevant academic and technical careers in the hydrocarbon energy sector.

Eligibility Requirements

To qualify for the scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be enrolled full-time in a bachelor's, associate, or technical certification program at an accredited college, university, or vocational/technical institution. Graduate students are not eligible.
- Be pursuing a course of study aligned with career goals in the hydrocarbon energy industry.
- Preference is given to students aiming for careers in measurement and control.
- Be enrolled in a technical certification program related to the hydrocarbon industry or have completed at least 50% of the required coursework in their program at the time of application.
- Maintain a minimum 2.75 GPA overall and a 3.0 GPA in major coursework, based on a 4.0 scale.
- Submit a fully completed ISHM scholarship application by the designated deadline.
- Meet all legal and regulatory eligibility requirements for receiving scholarship funds from ISHM, a registered 501(c)(3) organization in the State of Oklahoma. (See "Disclosure of Relationships")

Use of Funds

Scholarship funds shall be used for 1) tuition, 2) books, manuals and required study guides/materials 3) required academic, facility or laboratory fees, 4) required equipment (laboratory, small tools, etc.), 5) room and board costs if such are provided and administered by the college, university, or vocational/technical institution of attendance, or 6) other substantiated costs associated with the degree or certification program.

Selection and Recognition

Recipients are selected by the ISHM Scholarship Fund Committee from a pool of qualified applicants. Scholarships may vary in amount and number awarded each year. Awardees are recognized during the School's General Assembly. Funding is made possible through individual, group, and corporate donations, as well as special fundraising activities organized by the ISHM Executive Committee.

Instructions for Completing the Scholarship Application

The ISHM Scholarship Application Form is a vital part of the selection process and must be completed with care. Applicants are expected to answer all questions thoroughly and legibly—either typed or printed clearly in blue or black ink. Incomplete or illegible applications may be disqualified at the discretion of the ISHM Scholarship Fund Committee.

All fields on the form must be completed. If a question does not apply, please indicate "N/A" or "None" rather than leaving it blank. Additional supporting information may be attached to the application if relevant.

Grade Point Average (GPA) details must reflect the most recent semester completed at the time of submission.

Completed applications must be submitted to ISHM by the specified deadline. Scholarships awarded through this application will apply to the Fall and Spring semesters of the program year, with funds distributed in December. If submitting the application via email, it is strongly recommended to follow up with a confirmation request to ensure receipt. Mailed applications should also be sent with sufficient time to meet the deadline.
